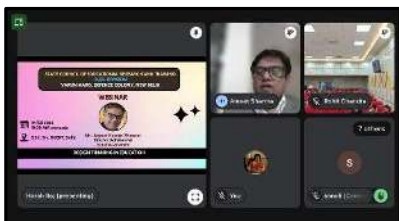


13 February 2026 | International Webinar on Entrepreneurship and Innovation
