1 August 2025 | Cleanliness Drive - “Live Life Cleaner, Make Earth Greener”



Trainees of the B.Ed. 07 October 2025 | Extension Lecture on Nutrition for Child Development

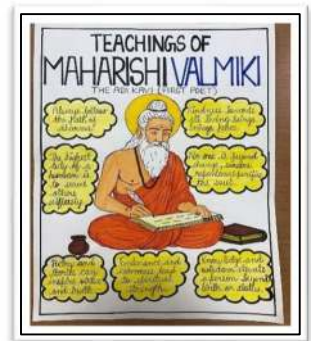

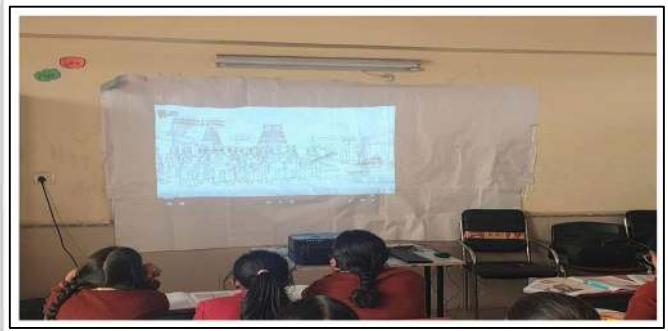
8 December 2025 | Innovative Internship Teaching Practices
